SERMON QUESTIONS:

1. Pray
2. What do you consider to be the “poverty line”?
3. In general, poverty is a part of this world because of the “fall due to sin” ... however, there are a variety of other factors that impact poverty, including: foolishness (Proverbs 13:18, 21:5), injustice (Proverbs 13:23), “spin cycle poverty” (Proverbs 28:3), and sovereign outcomes (Proverbs 10:22; 28:22). How have you seen these contribute to the poverty you have seen or personally experienced in the world?
4. Is there any foolishness in your own life (contributing to financial problems) that you need to change?
5. What are some things you can do to help the poor around you physically AND relationally?
6. What is one need you can meet in the life of another this month in the church or in the community? (Proverbs 11:24-25; 21:13; 22:9; 28:27)
7. Throughout this series, we looked at a number of Proverbs related to money. What has stood out to you most from this series?
8. What is one particular application you took away from this message?
