SERMON QUESTIONS:

1. Pray
2. Read Matthew 9:35-38
3. Pete said this morning that we are all tempted to read our Bibles like we read a yearbook ... flipping through the pages to see the places where we find "us." The reality is that the Bible is a book about God, His creation, His creation's rebellion, and God's plan to redeem it in Christ. The Bible is a story about Him and not just me. Did you connect with this idea? In what ways?
4. In Matthew 9:35-38, what did Jesus SEE when He looked at the crowds? What do you SEE when you look around at the world around you?
5. In Matthew 9:35-38, what did Jesus FEEL as He looked at the crowds? What do you FEEL as you look at the world around you?
6. In Matthew 9:35-38, what did Jesus SAY? Have you prayed the prayer that Jesus invites His followers to pray in response to what we FEEL about what we see in the world around us?
7. There are 3.2 Billion people around the world today who have no access to the Gospel of Jesus Christ. In light of this, what are we to do as individuals and the church?
8. What stands out to you most from this message? Any particular takeaway?
